The Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Pharmacy, Thergaon, (Kalewadi), Pune 411033 (contract acceptor) and M/S. M/S. SRUJAN HEALTHCARE. Gut no. 349, Krupa Industrial Area, Shade No.2, At/ Post-Bhare, Tal. Mulshi, Pune-412115 (contract giver) signed a Memorandum of Understanding on Collaboration in Pharmaceutical Product Development Analytical Research & Development Work on 01<sup>st</sup> December, 2020.

Participants have reached the following understanding:

**SECTION 1**

Objective

The objective of the collaboration under this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) will be continue, expand, and maximize cooperation in research and development between the Participants collaboration under this MOU will not preclude other bilateral or multilateral cooperation activities in research and development in which each Participant may take part.

**SECTION 2**

Scope

1. Collaboration under this MOU may include, but is not limited to, the following fields:
  - a. Herbal Product development
  - b. Standardization of the pharmaceutical raw materials and / or products
  - c. Analytical method development
  - d. Analytical support in some cases as the need arises.
  - e. Industrial training and visit for students and faculty.
  - f. Placement for the students.
  - g. Support for entrepreneurship activity in terms of career guidance session and field visit.
  - h. Consultancy and Services
2. Other collaborative fields may be added by written arrangement of the Participant.



### SECTION 3

#### Forms of Collaborative Activities

1. Collaboration in accordance with this MOU may include, but is not limited to, the following forms:
  - a. Exchange of all forms of unclassified scientific and technical information and results of research and development for the projects mutually agreed to do;
  - b. Exchange of scientists, other specialists, including those from industry, for participation in research, development, analysis, design and experimental activities conducted in research centers, laboratories, and other facilities and enterprises of each Participant;
  - c. Exchange of samples, materials, instruments and components for testing for the projects mutually agreed to do;
  - d. Organization of seminars, workshops, and other meetings on specific topics;
  - e. Visits by specialist teams or individuals to the facilities of the other Participant;
  - f. The use by one Participant of the facility (ies) owned or operated by the other Participant. Such use of facilities will be the subject of a separate written arrangement and may be subject to commercial terms or conditions;
  - g. Cooperative programs and projects in which the Participants decide to share the work and costs. Such joint projects will be the subject of a separate written arrangement between the Participants.
2. Other specific forms of cooperation may be added by written arrangement of the Participants.

### SECTION 4

#### Older Entities

1. Participants will encourage and facilitate, where appropriate, the development under this MOU direct contacts and cooperation between universities, science and research centers, institutes and institutions, private sector firms.
2. To supervise the cooperation under this MOU, each Participant will designate a Lead Coordinator. Each Participant will also designate a Technical Coordinator to assist the Lead Coordinator in carrying out activities under this MOU.

The Lead Coordinators will evaluate the status of cooperation under this MOU. This evaluation will elude a review of the past year's activities and accomplishments and of the activities planned for the coming year within each of the fields listed in Section 2,

### SECTION 5

#### Intellectual Property; Business-Confidential Information

The Participants do not anticipate the generation of intellectual property from the activities under this MOU or the exchange of business-confidential information. If the Participants determine that a particular activity may lead to the creation of intellectual property or the exchange of business confidential information, they will consult with each other and make appropriate written arrangements for the protection and allocation of such intellectual property and business confidential information.





## SECTION 6

### Funding

1. Collaboration under this MOU will be subject to the availability of appropriated funds.
2. Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Pharmacy will raise requirement of chemicals and other materials for proposed work agreed between the two participants. M/S.SRUJAN HEALTHCARE would either supply those chemicals or materials.
3. In case Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Pharmacy has to make arrangements to buy the chemicals or materials M/S.SRUJAN HEALTHCARE would authorize to do so. Payment for the procurement of chemicals or other materials will be done by M/S.SRUJAN HEALTHCARE.
4. In addition to the above mentioned expenses MMCOP & M/S.SRUJAN HEALTHCARE will agree upon the fix amount as consultation charges towards the work assigned to MMCOP. On completion of the assignment MMCOP will raise the invoice for the work and will be submit to M/S.SRUJAN HEALTHCARE along with the report of the work completed. M/S.SRUJAN HEALTHCARE will pay the amount by DD in the name of Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Pharmacy, payable at Pune or by electronic bank transfer to Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Pharmacy.

## SECTION 7

### Equipment

The participants will provide the necessary premises and allow use of equipment for carrying out mutually agreed upon research work activities.

## SECTION 8

### Samples and Materials

1. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, the following provisions will apply to the transportation and use of samples and materials provided by one Participant to the other under this MOU:
2. Unless otherwise agreed by the Participants, all samples and materials provided by the sending Participant to the receiving Participant will remain the property of the sending Participant, and will be returned to the sending Participant upon completion of the mutually agreed activity.
3. Where one Participant requests that a sample or material be provided by the other Participant, the Participant providing the sample or material will bear all costs and expenses associated with the transportation of the sample or material from the location of the sending.
4. Subject to the provisions of Section 5, each Participant will promptly disclose to the other Participant all information arising before and after the examination or testing of samples or materials exchanged under this MOU.



**SECTION 9**

**General Provisions**

1. Cooperation under this MOU will be in accordance with the professional ethics and mutual understanding.
2. All questions related to the MOU arising during its term will be settled by the Participants through consultations with each other.

**SECTION 10**

**Documentation**

When Participant (contract giver) requests the work to the participant (contract acceptor) a written communication is to be given for the work. The Participant (contract acceptor), will (contract giver).

**SECTION 11**

**Entry into Operation, Amendment and Termination**

1. This MOU will enter into operation upon the last date of signature and remain in operation for a period of three years. This MOU may be amended or extended by written arrangement of the participants.
2. This MOU may be terminated at any time by either Participant upon six (6) months written notice to the other Participant. All joint efforts and experiments not completed at the expiration of the May be continued until their completion under the terms of this MOU.

Patil, Principal** (hereinafter referred as '**First Party**', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors - in-office, administrators and assigns).

AND

**Matruj Ayurveda Pharmacy Pvt. Ltd., Address: 48/A, Pune, Parvati Industrial Estate, opposite Adinath Society, Pune -Satara road, Pune, Maharashtra 411009**

**Dr. Vallabh Deshpande** (hereinafter referred to as "**Second Party**", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors - in-office, administrators and assigns). (First Party and Second Party are hereinafter jointly referred to as '**Parties**' and individually as '**Party**') as

**WHEREAS:**

A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named: **Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Pharmacy, Pune**

B) **Matruj Ayurveda Pharmacy Pvt. Ltd., Pune, India**, the Second Party is engaged in giving the best ayurvedic health supplements to the society.

C) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

D) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Training, Marketing, Education, Research and Placement to students.

E) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MoU for advancing their mutual interests.



NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

### CLAUSE 1

#### CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MoU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

### CLAUSE 2

#### SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1. The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in marketing up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.

**Curriculum Design:** Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the marketing scenario meaningfully.

**Guest Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.

**Placement of Trained Students:** Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs; and will facilitate placements for the students.







- 2.5. **Industrial Training & Visits:** Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight in to the latest developments / requirements of the Ayurved pharma industry. The Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops / Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.
- 2.6. **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the marketing field of Pharmacy.
- 2.7. **Skill Development Programs:** Second Party to train the students of First Party on the marketing in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 2.8. **Faculty Development Programs:** Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party for imparting training as per the industrial requirement considering the National Occupational Standards in concerned sector, if available.
- 2.9. Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Program on the terms specified herein
- 2.10. There is no financial commitment on the part of the Name of institution, the First Party to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

### CLAUSE 3

#### INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 3.1. Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

### CLAUSE 4

#### VALIDITY

- 4.1. This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period Name of Industry, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MoU. Any act on the part of Training Partner or Name of Industry, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MoU. Both Parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations





**CLAUSE 3**

**RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES**

3.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)

Between

Marathwada Mitra Mandal's, College of Pharmacy.

&

Rubicon Skill Development Pvt. Ltd.

For Training students on Rubicon's Campus to Corporate Program

This Memorandum of Understanding is made at Pune on 05th day of July 2019.

Marathwada Mitra Mandal's, College of Pharmacy, Pune Maharashtra. (India) hereinafter referred to as "THE COLLEGE" (Which term shall so far as the context admits be deemed to mean and include its successors and assigns) of the First Part,

AND

Rubicon Skill Development Private Limited a Company incorporated and registered under the Companies Act, 2013, having its Corporate office at 801, 8<sup>th</sup> Floor, Tower 1, World Trade Centre, Pune - 411014, Maharashtra, hereinafter referred to as "Rubicon" (which term shall so far as the context admits be deemed to mean and include its successors, administrators, executors and assignees) of the Second Part.

**1. Introduction**

THE COLLEGE has decided to partner with RUBICON for the conduct of Tomorrow's Foundation Connect with Work Program (hereinafter referred to as "Training Program") at THE COLLEGE.

**2. THE COLLEGE Responsibilities:**

2.1. Shall nominate one person with adequate accountability and responsibility to coordinate the Training Program. He / She would act as the single point of contact for the proposed Programme.

2.2. Shall make available the Infrastructure (Including IT infrastructure, applications and connectivity) required to conduct the Training Program.







13. Shall provide all the support services and facilities to RUBICON during the conduct of the said Training Program. Adequate power backup through UPS and DG supplies during the training sessions

2.4. Shall coordinate with RUBICON and facilitate conduct of all the assessments including the assessment to be conducted by the external agency (if any) identified by RUBICON, as per schedule communicated by RUBICON.

2.5. Provide lodging, wherever available, as per the standards of RUBICON for faculty conducting the Training Programme for the total duration of the Training Programme plus two days (one day prior and one day after closure). The lodging so planned to be provided should be with independent room (with attached toilet), regular water supply, clean, with access to boarding facilities, should have well lit approach and surroundings, have adequate safety & protection and peaceful environment.

2.6. Shall share the details of students in a prescribed format to ensure that there is no duplication of beneficiaries

2.7. This is a multi-year program to create social impact. The college shall share few details to assess the impact of the program. For e.g. Placement details of trained students will be required to assess the impact of the program from one year to another year.

### 3. Rubicon Responsibilities:

3.1. Will provide necessary training as per Training Programme requirements and curriculum for delivery as per Annexure I to this MOU

3.2. Will provide suitable faculties for the training exclusive for classroom training

3.3. Will conduct assessment of its own and also arrange external assessment as required.





#### 4. Other Terms & Conditions:

The following are other terms and conditions of engagement:

4.1. Batch Size: The batch size would need to be a min/ max of 35-40.

4.2. Each student would be made available for the Training Program for specified number of hours per day for the duration of the Training Program

4.3. Pre-assessment & Selection: RUBICON may carry out pre-assessment of the students who have applied for the course and shortlist the select candidates to undergo the Training Program. The final decision on selection of candidates eligible to take the Training Program shall be with RUBICON.

4.4. Programme schedule:

4.4.1. Training Program scheduled commencement date 25<sup>th</sup> July 2019

4.4.2. Scheduled Completion Date: and will be completed by not later than 27<sup>th</sup> July 2019

4.5. Commercial:

4.5.1. Training Fees: The training Fees is as follows,

Since this is a CSR funded Program there is no fee payable by THE COLLEGE for this Training Program

4.5.2. Payment Terms  
Not Applicable

4.6. Certification:

Students who are successful in the assessment conducted by RUBICON shall be awarded a certificate post completion of the training program.

4.7. Term of engagement:







This MoU is valid from the date of sign off by both parties for a period of Two years, however both parties agree that based on mutual agreement, the terms may be extended. Both parties also agree that terms may be renegotiated.

**4.8. Limitations and Warranties :**

Both parties agree that it would be their endeavour to prevent any liability arising out of default or non-compliance of the MoU terms by the other party.

**4.9. Termination:**

- 4.9.1. Both parties can terminate the MoU with a prior written thirty (30) day notice on default of terms of non-adherence to any condition or responsibilities by the other party as outlined in this MoU in case such default is not rectified within such 30 days.
- 4.9.2. Both parties also agree that it would be their professional endeavour that despite any termination of the MOU, progress would continue, without any prejudice to the ongoing Training Programmes, which would be without any hindrance and would be progressed for completion.

**General Terms:**

- 5.1. Both the parties may receive information proprietary to other party (the Confidential Information) in the course of performance of their obligations under this MOU. Confidential Information is not meant to include any information which (a) is publicly available (b) is rightfully received by the parties from third parties without accompanying secrecy obligations; (c) is already in either party's possession and was lawfully received from sources other than the parties or (d) is independently developed by the parties. The two bodies understand and acknowledge that the Confidential Information is valuable and confidential and agrees that it will at all times be kept in trust to be disclosed only to such persons as have a "need to know" the same for the effective implementation of this MOU and that it will only be used by the parties for the benefit of others.
- 5.2. Both the parties understand and agree that all written or other tangible data and documentation developed or procured by the other party in performing its obligations under this MOU, whether in printed or electronic form, belongs to other party and that other party will have all rights, titles and interests therein.







5.3. Both parties shall not use the name and brand of other party in any advertisement or make any public announcement without the prior written approval of the other.

5.4. Each party shall be at liberty to terminate this MOU with a written notice period of three (3) month to the other party without any compensation and seeking legal redress.

**6. Jurisdiction:**

In the event of any litigation, the court of jurisdiction shall be Pune.

**7. Indemnification**

Both parties agree to indemnify each other and hold the other party harmless from and against any claim, loss, liability, or expense, including, but not limited to, damages, patent, and trademark infringement, costs and attorneys' fees, arising out of or in connection with any acts or omissions of their agents or employees, as related to the terms of this MoU.

Any claim, compensation, case initiated by any student against Aricent in relation to the Training Program due to any acts or omissions of COLLEGE and/or RUBICON shall be defended and contested by the COLLEGE and RUBICON at their sole expenses and cost keeping Aricent indemnified from the same.

**8. Limitation of Liability:**

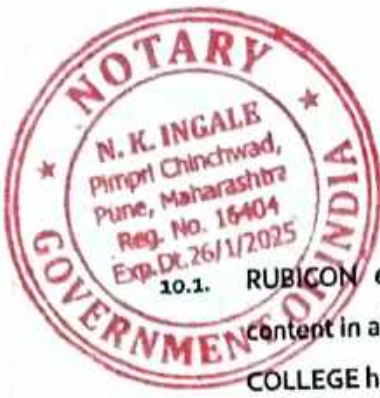
Except for the indemnification obligations, both parties agree that the liability would be limited to the amount of actual transactions between the two parties

**9. Notices:**

Any notices under this MOU will be sent by certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, to the respective address of Parties as contained in this MOU. Such notice will be effective upon its mailing as specified.

**10. Intellectual Property Rights**





10.1. RUBICON explicitly warrants that it owns all the intellectual properties related to content in all formats, the technology framework and all other related objects and the THE COLLEGE has no rights to use the content and mode of delivery for any other purpose.

10.2. Each party hereby undertakes to inform the other party of any violation of Intellectual Property Rights or its unlawful use, under prevalent laws of India. Further, each of the party herein, agrees to co-operate with the other to the extent possible in the process of investigating such cases of any violation of Intellectual Property Rights or its unlawful use and taking legal action against the said infringement.

10.3. Upon expiration of this MoU, or two years period of time from the date of completion of the courses, whichever is later, each party hereby agrees that it shall not make any claim on the Trade Name or the copyrights of the other, which belongs exclusively to the other party, nor shall either party use any trade name which is deceptively or confusingly similar to the trade name of the other.

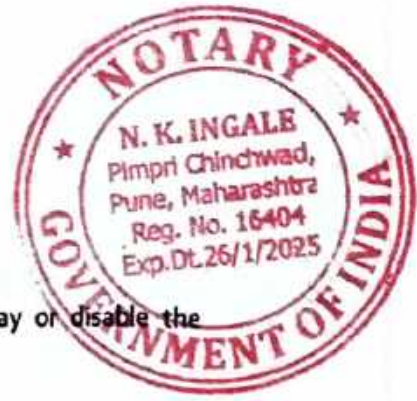
#### 11. Force Majeure:

11.1. Neither party to this MOU shall be liable for any failure or delay on its part in performing any of its obligations under this MOU, if such failure or delay shall be result of or arising out of Force Majeure conditions and, provided that the party claiming Force Majeure shall use its best efforts to avoid or remove such cause of non-performance and shall fulfil and continue performance hereunder with the utmost dispatch whenever and to the extent such cause or causes are removed.

Such events include acts of God, acts or omissions of any Government or agency thereof, compliance with rules, regulations or order of any Government Authority. Provided however, if either party claims that existence of any of the aforesaid conditions is delaying or disabling the performance by said party of its obligations under this MOU, such party shall give immediate notice to the other party of







the existence of such conditions whose existence are claimed to delay or disable the performance of obligations as aforesaid.

Whereas,

The Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Pharmacy, Thergaon (Kalewadi), Pune 411 033 (contract acceptor) and M/S. Scitech Laboratories Pvt. Ltd., B-21/22, STICE, Musalgaon, Nashik 422 112 (contract giver) signed a Memorandum of Understanding on Collaboration in Pharmaceutical Product Development, Analytical Research and Development on 01<sup>st</sup> November, 2016;

The Participants have reached the following understanding:

**SECTION 1**

Objective

The objective of the collaboration under this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) will be to continue, expand, and maximize cooperation in research and development between the Participants. Collaboration under this MOU will not preclude other bilateral or multilateral cooperation activities in research and development in which each Participant may take part.

**SECTION 2**

Scope

1. Collaboration under this MOU may include, but is not limited to, the following fields:
  - a. Herbal Product development
  - b. Standardization of the pharmaceutical raw materials and / or products
  - c. Analytical method development
  - d. Analytical support in some cases as the need arises.
2. Other collaborative fields may be added by written arrangement of the Participants.



### SECTION 3

#### Forms of Collaborative Activities

1. Collaboration in accordance with this MOU may include, but is not limited to, the following forms:
  - a. Exchange of all forms of unclassified scientific and technical information and results of research and development for the projects mutually agreed to do;
  - b. Exchange of scientists, other specialists, including those from industry, for participation in research, development, analysis, design and experimental activities conducted in research centers, laboratories, and other facilities and enterprises of each Participant;
  - c. Exchange of samples, materials, instruments and components for testing for the projects mutually agreed to do;
  - d. Organization of seminars, workshops, and other meetings on specific topics;
  - e. Visits by specialist teams or individuals to the facilities of the other Participant;
  - f. The use by one Participant of the facility(ies) owned or operated by the other Participant. Such use of facilities will be the subject of a separate written arrangement and may be subject to commercial terms or conditions;
  - g. Cooperative programs and projects in which the Participants decide to share the work and costs. Such joint projects will be the subject of a separate written arrangement between the Participants.
2. Other specific forms of cooperation may be added by written arrangement of the Participants.

### SECTION 4

#### Other Entities

The Participants will encourage and facilitate, where appropriate, the development under this MOU of direct contacts and cooperation between universities, science and research centers, institutes and institutions, private sector firms.

2. To supervise the cooperation under this MOU, each Participant will designate a Lead Coordinator. Each Participant will also designate a Technical Coordinator to assist the Lead Coordinator in carrying out activities under this MOU.

The Lead Coordinators will evaluate the status of cooperation under this MOU. This evaluation will include a review of the past year's activities and accomplishments and of the activities planned for the coming year within each of the fields listed in Section 2,

### SECTION 5

#### Intellectual Property; Business-Confidential Information

The Participants do not anticipate the generation of intellectual property from the activities under this MOU or the exchange of business-confidential information. If the Participants determine that a particular activity may lead to the creation of intellectual property or the exchange of business confidential information, they will consult with each other and make appropriate written arrangements for the protection and allocation of such intellectual property and business confidential information.





## SECTION 6

### Funding

1. Collaboration under this MOU will be subject to the availability of appropriated funds.
2. Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Pharmacy, Thergaon (Kalewadi), Pune will raise requirement of chemicals and other materials for proposed work agreed between the two participants. M/S Scitech Laboratories Pvt. Ltd. would either supply those chemicals or materials.
3. In case Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Pharmacy, Thergaon (Kalewadi), Pune has to make arrangements to buy the chemicals or materials M/S Scitech Laboratories Pvt. Ltd. would authorize to do so. Payment for the procurement of chemicals or other materials will be done by M/S Scitech Laboratories Pvt. Ltd.
4. In addition to the above mentioned expenses MM COP & M/s. Scitech Laboratories Pvt. Ltd. will agree upon the fix amount as consultation charges towards the work assigned to MMCOP. On completion of the assignment MMCOP will raise the invoice for the work and will be submit to M/s. Scitech Laboratories Pvt. Ltd. along with the report of the work completed. M/s. Scitech Laboratories Pvt. Ltd. will pay the amount by DD in the name of Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Pharmacy, payable at Pune or by electronic bank transfer to Marathwada Mitra Mandal's College of Pharmacy.
