**RULES OF ADMISSION TO
FIRST YEAR OF FOUR YEAR FULL TIME DEGREE COURSE IN PHARMACY
FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2015-2016**

Ref. G.R.No TEM 2015/C.N.31/TE-4 Dated 24th February 2015 issued by the Higher and Technical Education Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai 400020

1. Introduction

The online entrance examination MT-CET-2015 for the admission to all **Pharmacy degree courses** in State of Maharashtra for the academic year 2015-2016 shall be conducted by the Competent Authority appointed by Government of Maharashtra on **25th and 26th April 2015**, in the State of Maharashtra.

This brochure gives the rules and information regarding the distribution of seats under various heads i.e. Home University (HU), Outside Home University (OHU), Institute Level seats, Minority seats, Outside Maharashtra State (OMS) seats etc.; details of the Reservation and provision of seats, Fees concession offered to eligible candidates, details of the Centralized Admission Process (CAP), details of the Admission rounds, Institute wise Information, etc.

These rules also incorporate the guidelines (Annexure-II) for the rules of admissions, which are to be carried out by the unaided institutes for Institute level seats and for the seats remaining vacant after the Centralized Admission Rounds.

3.2. Outside Maharashtra State Candidate:

Type of candidature: Outside Maharashtra State candidate (OMS)	OMS candidate should be an Indian national candidate who is not satisfying any of the conditions Stated in Sr. No. 1, 2, 3, 4 (i.e. Type A,B,C,D) of rule 3.1 and should have passed HSC(Std. XII) examination from an institute <i>situate</i> outside State of Maharashtra within India.

Note:

- For claiming facility under Type A, B, C, & D, it is binding for the candidates to produce the documentary proof along with the application form for CAP to claim the facility.
- Candidate can claim only one type of candidature while submitting the application form for CAP.
- The candidate should submit the applicable certificate in the necessary proforma at the time of filling up of Application Form for CAP.
- Eligible OMS candidates shall also be considered on the basis of score of MT-CET 2015, for Admission to **institute level seats in Unaided Private Institutes**. The details of the admission process for filling up seats at the institute level are given in Annexure-II.

4. Reservations

All the reservations given below shall be applicable to candidates belonging to Maharashtra State only subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities from time to time.

4.1. Reservation for Backward Class category Candidates:

The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra State is as per the details in table given below. The percentages of reservation are the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates, which are coming under the purview of the Competent Authority. These are the minimum percentages of reservation exclusive of the backward class candidates securing allotment through General Merit by virtue of merit. Backward class candidates shall claim the category to which they belong to at the time of submission of application form for Centralized Admission.

4.2. Reservation for sons/daughters of Defence service personnel:

Five (5) % seats of the total sanctioned intake for an institute, subject to a maximum of five (5) seats in each institute coming under CAP shall be reserved for

- Children of ex- service personnel who are domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-1).
- Children of active service personnel who are domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-2).
- Children of active service personnel (DEF-3) -
 - Who are transferred to Maharashtra State but are not domiciled in Maharashtra State,
 - Who are not domiciled in Maharashtra State but their families are stationed in Maharashtra State under the provision of retention of family accommodation at the last duty station on grounds of children's education provided further that, such candidate should have appeared and passed the HSC (Std.XII) examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent examination from a school/college situate in the State of Maharashtra.

These seats are within the sanctioned intake capacity and are available as **State Level seats**. A combined single merit list of all eligible DEF1, DEF2 & DEF3 candidates shall be prepared. Admission against the Defence category seats will be made strictly on the basis of inter se merit of combined single merit list of all eligible DEF1, DEF2 & DEF3 candidates. Refer Proforma C, D and E for claiming this provision.

Note: This provision is NOT available to the children of CIVILIAN STAFF who is working/ who has worked in the Indian Defence Service.

4.3. Reservation for Persons with Disability Candidates:

- As per the provisions in Clause 39 of Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation Act 1995, three (3) per cent seats of total sanctioned intake capacity of all the institutions coming under CAP shall be reserved for Persons with Disability candidates under the following categories:
 - visually impaired (blind) candidates (P1)
 - speech & hearing impaired (deaf & dumb) candidates, (P2)
 - Orthopedic disorders, learning disabilities, Dyslexia, Dyscalculia, Dysgraphica, Spastic (P3).

Allotment of the seats reserved for the Persons with Disability candidates shall be done on the basis of a respective inter-se merit of such candidates. These seats are available in 70% Home University area seats only.



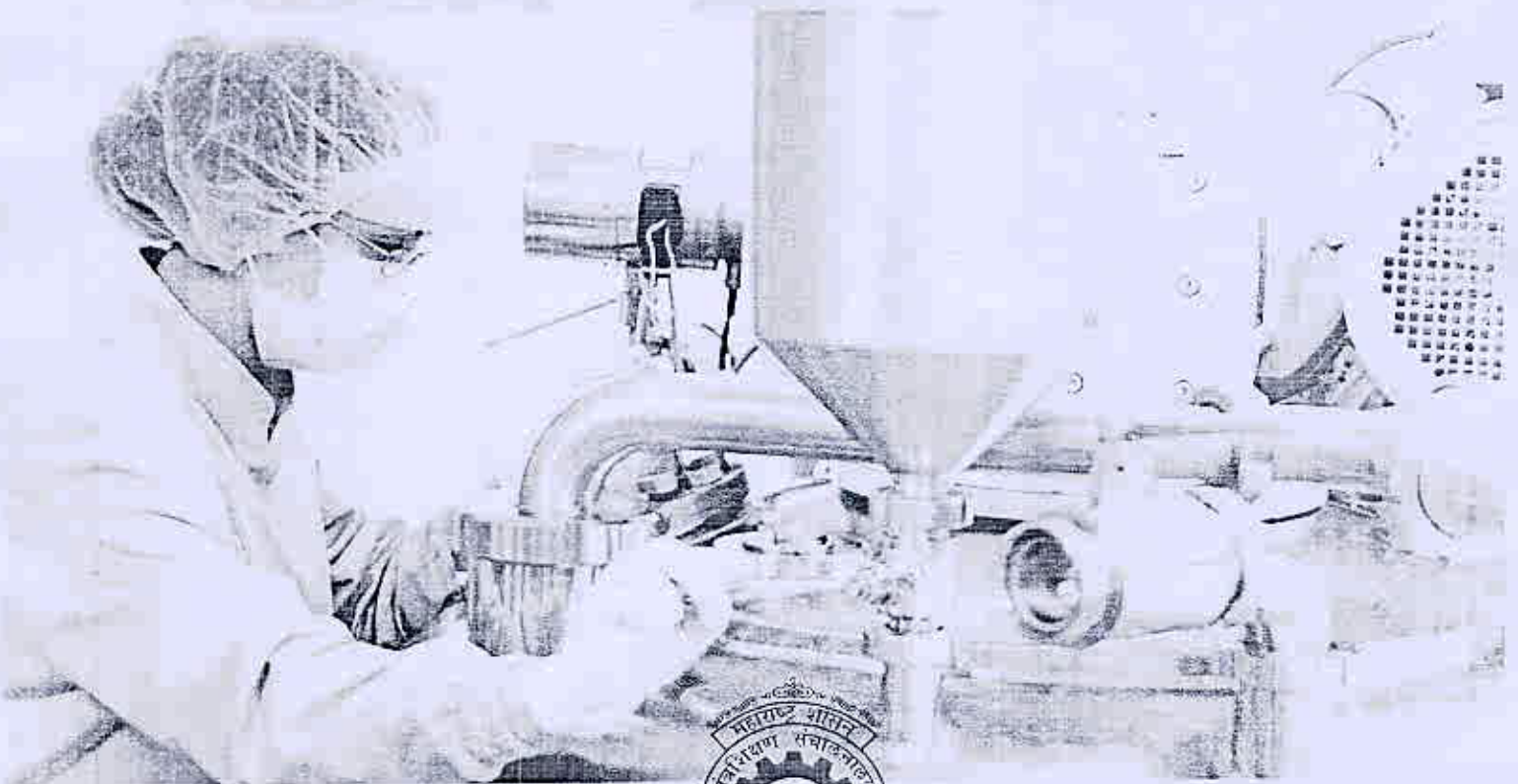

2.3 General Notes on Eligibility:

1. Candidate Passing SSC (Std. X)/ HSC (Std. XII) / any other Equivalent Examination and / or Diploma Course in Pharmacy Examination as Specified in rule 2.1 from a Recognized Institution situated outside the State of Maharashtra.

and

Not satisfying any of the Conditions stated in Sr. No. 2, 3, 4 (i.e. Type B,C,D) above as regards to parent's status are not Eligible for Admission through CAP and also in Government/Government Aided / Government Aided University managed Institutes / University Departments for any subsequent Institute level rounds. However, these Candidates are Eligible for the seats remaining vacant after Admitting Maharashtra Candidates in the Unaided Institutes.

2. If letter grades are assigned instead of marks at SSC / HSC / Diploma or its equivalent examination the candidate must obtain the certificate of conversion of letter of grades into marks from the competent authority where from the candidate has passed the examination. The candidate should produce such certificate at the time of submission of application form. The Eligibility shall be decided based on the equivalent marks submitted by such candidates
3. Admission of any Candidate made at the Institution shall be Provisional, subject to the acceptance / production of Eligibility Certificate from the concerned University and the final approval to the merit list of second year Degree Pharmacy Course by the Director of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Mumbai. If Candidate fails to get Eligibility, his Admission may be cancelled at any stage.
4. Candidates admitted to Direct Second Year B. Pharmacy Class will have to appear and pass in the subject of Industrial Psychology prescribed in F.Y. B. Pharmacy syllabus in addition to producing passing Certificate in Mathematics / Biology at XII Std Examination of Higher Secondary Board in Maharashtra State, if he / she has not offered / passed in any / both the subjects. Failing to production of this Certificate, the student will not be promoted to third year Degree in Pharmacy.
5. Candidates passing Diploma in Pharmacy from Institution not approved by AICTE/PCI are not eligible and therefore shall not have any claim on Admission.

3.0 Reservation of Seats:

The reservation for backward class category candidates and persons with disability candidates, Female candidate, Son/Daughter of Defence Personnel shall be applicable. The seats shall be distributed in such a way that the percentage of reservation shall be followed at state level. The decision of Competent Authority regarding distribution of seats amongst various backward class categories / persons with disability categories / Female/Defence Category shall be mandatory for all the applicants/ institutes.

3.1 Reservation for Backward Class category Candidates:

The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra State is as per the details in table given below. The percentages of reservation are the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates, which are coming under the purview of the Competent Authority. These are the minimum percentages of reservation exclusive of the backward class candidates securing allotment through General Merit by virtue of merit. Backward class candidates shall claim the category to which they belong to at the time of submission of application.

3.1.1 Reservation for Persons with Disability Candidates:

As per the provisions in Clause 39 of Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation Act 1995, three percent (3%) seats of CAP Seats shall be reserved for persons with disability candidates.

- visually impaired (blind) candidates (P1)
- speech & hearing impaired (deaf & dumb) candidates, (P2)
- Orthopedic disorders, learning disabilities, Dyslexia, Dyscalculia, Dysgraphia, Spastic (P3)

Allotment of the seats reserved for the Persons with Disability candidates shall be done on the basis of a respective inter-se merit of respective category of such candidates. **These seats are available only for Maharashtra Domiciled candidates.**

Note:-

It should be noted that the persons with disability candidates on admission to Pharmacy degree course will not be given any exemptions or additional facilities in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the respective Universities. Further it is specifically brought to the notice of persons with disability candidates that, they should submit the certificates strictly as per the Proforma- F/F-1.

3.1.2 Reservation for Son/Daughter of Defence service personnel

Five (5) % seats of the CAP seats for an institute, subject to a maximum of five (5) seats in each institute coming under CAP shall be reserved for

- Children of ex- service personnel who are domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-1).
- Children of active service personnel who are domiciled in Maharashtra State (DEF-2)
- Children of active service personnel (DEF-3) -
 - Who are transferred to Maharashtra State but are not domiciled in Maharashtra State.
 - Who are not domiciled in Maharashtra State but their families are stationed in Maharashtra State under the provision of retention of family accommodation at the last duty station on grounds of children's education provided further that, such candidate should have appeared and passed the Diploma examination of Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education or its equivalent examination from a Polytechnic / Institute situated in the State of Maharashtra.

A combined single merit list of all eligible DEF1, DEF2 & DEF3 candidates shall be prepared. Admission against the Defence category seats will be made strictly on the basis of inter-se-merit combined single merit list of all eligible DEF1, DEF2 & DEF3 candidates

Refer Proforma C, D and E for claiming this provision.

Note:-

This provision is NOT available to the children of CIVILIAN STAFF who is working / who has worked in the Indian Defence Service.

3.1.3 Reservation for Female

As per the provisions in Government Resolution No. SEC-1000/ (123/2000)/ Tech. Edu.-1, dated 17th April, 2000, 30% of CAP seats shall be reserved for female candidates in all the courses of the institutions coming under CAP. This reservation shall be applicable for General, SC, ST, P1/V) (NT-A), NT-B, NT-C, NT-D and OBC categories. There shall be no reservation for female candidates under Defence, Persons With Disability and SBC categories.

General Notes:

1. The reservation for backward class candidate i.e. 50% as stated above shall be available in Government, Government Aided Institutes, University Department, University Managed Institutes and Unaided Non-Minority institutes.

7.1.1. Non-sponsored seats

Admissions will be effected according to merit list prepared on the basis of valid and qualified GPAT 2015 All India Rank / Total score obtained only. When enough no. of GPAT 2015 qualified candidates are not available the vacant seats shall be offered to the non-GPAT candidates, as per inter se merit of MAH-MPH-CET 2015 score. If candidates of Home University are not available, then the vacant seats shall be offered to candidates of Universities of Maharashtra in the order of *inter-se-merit*.

7.1.2. Sponsored seats

Admissions to sponsored candidates with valid and current sponsorship letter shall be given in the following order of preference:

1. Candidates with GPAT 2015 qualification with minimum of 2 years experience.
2. Non-GPAT candidates with minimum of 2 years experience and qualified in MAH-MPH-CET 2015.

In case of preferences 1, Merit list will be prepared based on GPAT-2015 All India Rank / Total Score obtained. In case of preferences 2, merit list will be prepared based on marks awarded in MAH-MPH-CET 2015.

Admission to candidates under sponsored category will be effected according to merit list prepared on the basis of GPAT-2015 All India Rank / Total Score followed by MAH-MPH-CET 2015 score.

7.1.3. SC/ST Seats

1. The admissions to this category are available to the SC & ST category candidates belonging to the State of Maharashtra only.
2. Admissions will be effected according to merit list prepared on the basis of valid and qualified GPAT-2015 All India Rank / Total Score only.
3. When enough GPAT-2015 qualified candidates are not available the vacant seats shall be offered to the non-GPAT candidates, as per merit based on MAH-MPH-CET 2015 score.

Seats reserved for SC / ST shall be made available for the candidates belonging to these categories only. Out of total (e.g. 03) seats reserved for SC / ST, two third seats (i.e. 02) shall be reserved for SC and one third seat (i.e. 01) for ST category. In the event of non availability of the candidates in one of the category and availability of more number of applicants in other category, there will be conversion permitted within allotted seats and maximum of total seats (e.g. 03) in either of SC or ST could be permitted to be filled.

7.2 Admission Procedure

- a) Rules and Information Brochure 2015-16 is available on the website www.dtemaharashtra.gov.in
- b) Candidates have to download the information brochure from website and read in thoroughly before filling the online application form.
- c) **Online Application form filing:** Candidates are required to fill online application form (as per the notification published in newspapers and on website) and upload the photograph on web site www.dtemaharashtra.gov.in Procure a printout of the online form. Check for various entries made in application. Correct them online if necessary.
