

However, 40% rated excellent in innovation.	➤ Students are encouraged to participate in innovation and incubation drive at college to strengthen their innovative skills.
11.	Employer Feedback	➤ Different employers rated the different domain viz. teaching learning, soft skills, ethics and innovations at “very good” to “excellent” level. However, none have rated excellent in “Problem solving abilities”	➤ Faculty was instructed to give assignments which required problem solving abilities. Moreover, faculty was also instructed to put some question in internal assessment which required higher order thinking skills.

Final Remark:

Different feedback analysis revealed that around 80% of the students were satisfied with quality of teaching learning process, laboratory facilities, extracurricular and co-curricular activities etc. This is the 360 degree structured feedback mechanism which sought views suggestions, difficulties, queries and upgradation from varied stakeholder of the system. Hence, it is observed that college provides a robust platform for student progress. However, lacuna and area of improvement were identified and rectified in timely fashion.
